

ORDER OF DISMISSAL

By correspondence dated 22 November 2016, appellant indicated that it desires to submit its claim to the contracting officer for a decision and requested the contracting officer's contact information. The government provided appellant with the contact information for the cognizant contracting officer and appellant submitted a claim to the contracting officer.
