OPINION BY ADMINISTRATIVE JUDGE YOUNGER ON THE GOVERNMENT'S MOTION TO DISMISS FOR LACK OF JURISDICTION

The government has filed a motion to dismiss this appeal, stating that the contracting officer has voluntarily agreed to pay appellant the remaining principal balance of its claim, plus accrued interest, and hence that the appeal is moot. The appeal is accordingly dismissed as moot.
