## OPINION BY ADMINISTRATIVE JUDGE MELNICK

The parties have resolved their dispute and request that the Board enter judgment in favor of appellant.

It is the Board's decision, pursuant to 41 U.S.C. §§ 7105(e), 7108(b), and the parties' stipulation and agreement, that the appeal is sustained. In the nature of a consent judgment, the Board makes a monetary award to appellant in the amount of \$900,000.00. This amount is inclusive of Contract Disputes Act interest. In the event the Government fails to pay Appellant the full monetary award within sixty (60) business days of the date of this decision, interest shall thereafter accrue, and will be calculated at rates authorized under the Prompt Payment Act, 31 U.S.C. § 3901 et seq., on the full unpaid amount, until such payment is made.
