

OPINION BY ADMINISTRATIVE JUDGE MCILMAIL

By decision dated July 8, 2019, the Board sustained ASBCA Nos. 60130 and 61611 and remanded to the parties for the negotiation of quantum. The parties have resolved quantum and request the Board to enter a final judgment against the government in the amount of \$855,000. The Board has assigned ASBCA No. 62299 to the quantum phase of ASBCA Nos. 60130 and 61611.

It is the Board's decision, pursuant to 41 U.S.C. §§ 7105(e), 7108(b), and the parties' stipulation and agreement, that the appeal is sustained. In the nature of a consent judgment, the Board makes a monetary award to appellant in the amount of \$855,000. This amount is inclusive of interest. No further interest shall be paid.
