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OPINION BY ADMINISTRATIVE JUDGE PAUL ON THE GOVERNMENT'S MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION

The Government has filed a timely motion for reconsideration of the Board's decision dated 23 January 2003. In that decision, which itself was in response to a motion for reconsideration, we accepted some of the Government's proposed amendments to its answer and rejected others. Familiarity with that decision is presumed. The Government asks us to reconsider the latter part of the ruling.

The Government's motion does not present new evidence, nor does it assert a previously unconsidered legal theory. *Danac, Inc.*, ASBCA No. 33394, 98-1 BCA ¶ 29,454 at 146,219. The matters raised by the Government were raised in the briefing on the motion to amend or in the briefing on the original motion for reconsideration.

Nevertheless, we shall discuss the parties' various contentions. First, it is clear that both sides misapprehend our earlier decision. The allegations in paragraphs 86 through 91 of the proposed amendment were struck because they tracked the language of the False Claims Act, 31 U.S.C. § 3729. We did not, as the Government asserts, rule that we lack jurisdiction over common law fraud asserted as an affirmative defense. And, contrary to appellant's suggestion, we did not accept the proposition that the Board could not hear an assertion that fraud occurred during the performance of a valid contract. Our rulings are limited to the factual situations presented, and our earlier decision should be understood in that light.

CONCLUSION

We have reconsidered our decision and affirm it.
