## OPINION BY ADMINISTRATIVE JUDGE FREEMAN ON RECONSIDERATION OF APPELLANT'S MOTION TO REOPEN THE RECORD

Management Resource Associates, Inc. (MRA) moves for reconsideration of our denial of its post-decision motion to reopen the record. That motion sought admission of "additional documents and schedules" to "clarify" the findings in the Board's 16 January 2003 decision on the merits. *See Management Resource Associates, Inc.*, ASBCA Nos. 49457, 50866, 04-1 BCA ¶ 32,491 at 160,721-22.

Appellant's sole stated ground for reconsideration is the hearing testimony of its accountant that he could not produce accounting documents within the time limit prescribed by a pre-hearing order because he was in the process of moving his office, his computers took a week to get "back up again," and then he was "on vacation" (app. mot. quoting tr. 484-86). These excuses border on the frivolous. In addition to the reasons set forth in our first decision on this motion, we cannot reasonably require the government to bear the added time and cost of a separate consideration, hearing and briefing of evidence that, but for the MRA accountant's office move and vacation, would have been presented pursuant to the Board's pre-hearing order in the initial disposition of these appeals.

On reconsideration, we affirm our denial of MRA's motion to reopen the record.
