## OPINION BY ADMINISTRATIVE JUDGE PEACOCK ON APPELLANT'S MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION

Appellant has timely moved for reconsideration of portions of our opinion in *L&C Europa Contracting Company, Inc.*, ASBCA No. 52617, 04-1 BCA ¶ 32,495. Appellant's supporting brief was filed on 21 April 2004. In our decision, we sustained the appeal as to two of appellant's 11 claims seeking equitable adjustments. Appellant requests that we reconsider our denial of the remaining nine claims. The general standards we apply in deciding a motion for reconsideration are whether the motion is based upon newly discovered evidence, errors in our fact findings or legal theories that the Board failed to consider in reaching its underlying decision. *E.g., Danac, Inc.*, ASBCA No. 33394, 98-1 BCA ¶ 29,454 at 146,219; *Sauer, Inc.*, ASBCA No. 39372, 96-2 BCA ¶ 28,620 at 142,897. The purpose of the motion is not to afford a party with the opportunity to reargue contentions that have been fully considered and rejected. *E.g., McDonnell Douglas Electronics Systems Co.*, ASBCA No. 45455, 99-1 BCA ¶ 30,132 at 149,057. In support of its motion, appellant has offered no facts or argument that we have not fully considered in rendering our earlier decision nor has it presented any other basis warranting reconsideration. The motion is, accordingly, denied. Dated: 2 August 2004
