OPINION BY ADMINISTRATIVE JUDGE THOMAS ON APPELLANT'S MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION

Appellant timely moves for reconsideration of our decision denying its appeal. UniTech Services Group, Inc., ASBCA No. 56482, 12-2 BCA ¶ 35,060. Appellant argues that we misapplied the law to the facts (mot. at 1). The government opposes the motion, stating that appellant is simply reiterating its previous arguments (opp'n at 1).

"Reconsideration is not intended to provide a party with the opportunity to reargue its position." *Zulco International, Inc.*, ASBCA No. 55441, 08-1 BCA ¶ 33,799 at 167,319. We have carefully considered appellant's arguments and conclude that the government is correct that appellant is simply reiterating its previous arguments. Accordingly, our prior decision is affirmed.
