OPINION BY ADMINISTRATIVE JUDGE GRANT ON APPELLANT'S MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION

On 27 December 2012, appellant Seven Seas Shipchandlers, LLC (Seven Seas) timely moved for reconsideration of the Board's decision dated 26 November 2012 denying Seven Seas' motion for partial summary judgment. Seven Seas Shipchandlers, LLC, ASBCA No. 57875 et al., 13-1 BCA ¶ 35,193. Seven Seas argues that the Board's decision contains errors of fact and law; the government opposes the motion on the basis that Seven Seas is simply re-asserting its original arguments.
