OPINION BY ADMINISTRATIVE JUDGE MELNICK
PURSUANT TO ALTERNATIVE DISPUTES RESOLUTION AGREEMENT

The parties entered into an Alternative Disputes Resolution Agreement and elected a summary trial with binding decision. The parties' agreement provides that this decision shall not contain findings of fact or conclusions of law. The parties agree that this decision shall be final and conclusive and not subject to reconsideration or appeal and may not be set aside except for fraud. The decision has no value as precedent.

## **DECISION**

The appeal is sustained to the extent that appellant is entitled to recover \$5,222.00, plus interest in accordance with 41 U.S.C. § 7109 running from 22 March 2009. Otherwise the appeal is denied.
