

OPINION BY ADMINISTRATIVE JUDGE MCILMAIL ON APPELLANT'S
MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION

Appellant requests reconsideration of our July 28, 2022 dismissal of its untimely appeal for lack of jurisdiction. ***, ASBCA No. 63216 (slip op., July 28, 2022). We have not requested a response from the government. *See John Shaw LLC d/b/a Shaw Building Maintenance*, ASBCA No. 61379, 18-1 BCA ¶ 37,026 at 180,294. A motion for reconsideration is not intended to allow a party to re-argue issues that were previously raised and decided. *Id.* Appellant's motion simply re-argues the case it made before we issued our decision; therefore, the motion for reconsideration is denied. *See Green Valley Co.*, ASBCA No. 61275, 18-1 BCA ¶ 37,044 at 180,330.




