ORDER OF DISMISSAL



On May 26, 2023, the Board issued an Order directing appellant to show that its June 6, 2022 claim was certified to the contracting officer and to provide a copy of the certification. By correspondence dated May 26, 2023, appellant informed the Board that it had filed a new, properly certified claim with the contracting officer and requested that the Board dismiss this appeal without prejudice. By correspondence dated June 2, 2023, the government informed the Board that it had no objection to appellant's request. Accordingly, the appeal dismissed from the Board's docket without prejudice.
